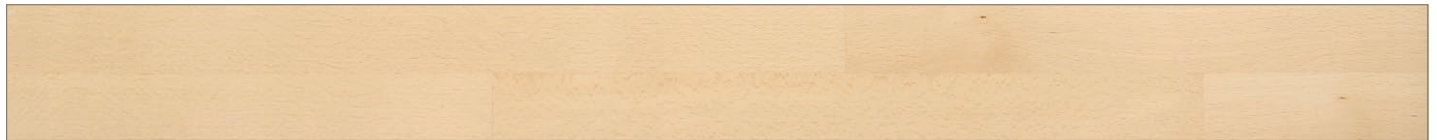

Healthy knots	to approx. 5 mm allowed
Black knots	to approx. 5 mm allowed
Healthy red heart	not allowed
Healthy black heart	not allowed
Cracks	not allowed
Curled Spots   differences in structure	not allowed
Natural colour differences	slightly allowed
Natural fiber orientation	not allowed
Wormholes and insect-ate-spots	not allowed
Sapwood	partly allowed
Red or brown spots	allowed
Stains from storage and light blueness	allowed
Knocked spots	not allowed
Mirror	slightly allowed
