Description 3 layers of the same hardwood. Due to the steaming with vitalized Grander water, the Black Walnut receives a light brown to intensive dark brown colour. The special feature is the occasional occurring sapwood. The sorting Klassiker is essentially knot-free*, with a simple structure.

Curled Spots differences in structure	allowed
Natural colour differences	allowed
Natural fiber orientation	partly allowed
Wormholes and insect-ate-spots	not allowed
Sapwood	allowed
Red or brown spots	not allowed
Stains from storage and light blueness	allowed
Knocked spots	not allowed
Mirror	not allowed
